Application

The AR series offers powerful axial intake (ARS) or exhaust (ARE) performance in a roof mount design that is compact, lightweight and easy to install. Available in 5 sizes with a CFM range from 268 to over 3100 CFM to .75 static pressure.

The direct drive design has no belts or fan bearings to maintain or adjust and consequently requires very little maintenance. The AR series is an excellent choice for factories, shops, restaurants, bathrooms, offices, schools and other similar applications where light to moderate static pressures are present. Equipped with explosion-proof motors, the AR series can be used in more severe applications. (Caution should be used to safely match the motor capabilities with the specific hazardous environment).

The low contour designs and all aluminum housing provides a modern, clean appearance in addition to excellent performance and durability.

- Exclusive U-Spring suspension compensates for both radial and lateral movement and provides 44% better vibration isolation than rubber isolators.

- Disconnect is standard on ODP motors (except two speed and explosion proof).



Typical Specification

Axial direct drive power roof ventilator shall be Model ARE (Exhaust) or Model ARS (Supply) as manufactured by Soler & Palau USA, Jacksonville, Florida.

Spun aluminum housing, venturi, and curb cap shall be heavy-gauge aluminum construction. Curb cap corners shall be welded not staked.

Aluminum propeller shall have steel hub and be statically and dynamically balanced and keyed to the motor shaft. Motor and propeller shall be mounted on a U-spring Suspension System for radial and axial vibration isolation. Rubber isolators are not acceptable.

Motors shall be of nationally recognized manufacturer with permanently lubricated bearings and provided with the specified voltage, phase, and enclosure. A wiring chase shall be provided for ease of electrical connection to the factory provided disconnect switch.

Fans will be available UL-705 listed and tested in accordance with AMCA 301 (Sound) and AMCA 210 (Air).

SOLER & PALAU LIMITED WARRANTY

Soler & Palau USA (manufacturer), 6393 Powers Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32217, warrants equipment of its manufacture to be free from defects in design, materials and workmanship (exclusive of abrasion, corrosion or erosion) for one (1) year from the date of shipment to the original purchaser or the date of notification of readiness to ship. Motor warranty is one (1) year. In order to claim the benefit of this warranty, buyer must notify manufacturer in writing of the claimed defect within ten (10) days after discovering it and return this equipment or parts to the factory with transportation prepaid. In the event of on-site repair, no service technician will be dispatched until manufacturer receives your written purchase order. If any of the following conditions exist, the warranty will be null and void: (I) Buyer has permitted other persons not approved or authorized by manufacturer to alter, adjust, replace or repair the equipment or any part there of. (2) Buyer has not followed instructions or other directions given in the contract documents or our maintenance manual. (3) When breakage or other loss or damage is the result of any negligence, misuse or fault on the part of any operator or other person not under our supervision or control. (4) The defect is the result of designs or drawings made, furnished or specified by others. (5) In the case of goods not manufactured but supplied by the manufacturer as part of a contract, manufacturer shall only be liable to the same extent that our supplier is to manufacturer, not to exceed any liability manufacturer would have for warranty on our own equipment. (6) Buyer has not paid in full any invoices submitted to buyer which are due for payment. (7) Unusual wear and tear of the equipment. Statements relating to the product, its use or installation made prior to the execution of the agreement, are not warranties except to the extent that the contrary is expressly set forth herein. It is understood that such statements were not intended to, and did not, form a part of the agreement; they were merely made in the course of negotiations of the parties. This warranty is in LIEU OF ANY OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE. OUR SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE OBLIGATION UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS TO REPAIR OR REPLACE DEFECTIVE EQUIPMENT OR PARTS OR, AT OUR OPTION, TO PAY THE REASONABLE COST OF REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT. BUYER AGREES THAT NO OTHER REMEDY (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, DAMAGES FOR LOST PROFITS OR SALES, OR DAMAGES FOR INJURIES TO PERSON OR PROPERTY) SHALL BE AVAILABLE.
